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### HEY FRIENDS!

I'm so excited you want to make your own Kids' Travel Play Food Kit! They are so much fun and I love that they're portable and travel-friendly! I hope you and the kiddos you're making these for enjoy it!



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### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Print the following pages on 8.5"x11" letter size paper or cardstock. If you are able to print on cardstock, you can print on both sides. If you're using standard computer paper, you will just print on one side.
2. Start warming up your laminator and set to High.
3. Cut out each table setting with scissors or a paper trimmer.
4. If you have 4"x6" laminating pouches, insert your table settings. If you have 8.5"x11" pouches, fit as many table settings in as you can, leaving about 1/2" in between the papers. If you have only printed on one side of the paper, place 2 table settings back to back inside the pouches.
5. Run through the laminator (sealed side first).
6. If you're using the 8.5"x11" pouch, trim them down now.
7. That's it! Enjoy!
